

Frequently Asked Questions about **BRINSUPRI for Bronchiectasis**

What is BRINSUPRI, and what is it used for?

BRINSUPRI is a newly FDA-approved medication for the treatment of non-cystic fibrosis bronchiectasis (NCFB). It is the first and only FDA-approved medicine for this condition. BRINSUPRI works by targeting a key driver of inflammation in bronchiectasis, helping to reduce exacerbations (flare-ups) and lung function decline.

Who can take BRINSUPRI?

BRINSUPRI is approved for use in patients aged 12 years and older, including both adults and children with bronchiectasis.

What doses are BRINSUPRI available in, and how should it be taken?

BRINSUPRI is available in 10 mg and 25 mg tablets. Each dose is taken by mouth once daily, with or without food. Your doctor will discuss with you which dose they will prescribe.

What are the side effects of BRINSUPRI?

Medications can affect each person differently, and side effects will vary. Speak to your health care provider if you have concerns about how BRINSUPRI may affect you.

Can I take BRINSUPRI if I am pregnant or breastfeeding?

The safety of using BRINSUPRI while pregnant or breastfeeding has not been established. Discuss with your health care provider to weigh the potential risks and benefits.

How do I get started with BRINSUPRI?

Your doctor will evaluate if you are a good candidate for BRINSUPRI. If so, he/she writes a prescription and gives you guidance on starting treatment. BRINSUPRI can only be obtained from certain specialty pharmacies. Talk to your doctor about what options are available to you.

What is the price for this medication? Will insurance cover it?

Insurance coverage will depend on your individual insurance plan/carrier. Check with your insurance and speak to your health care provider regarding treatment coverage.
